- Repeal of extension of hours of operation at all Parking Meters in Davis Sq and Magoun Sq to 10pm;
- Repeal of Article V Section 5-7 “Residential Permit Parking Program Approval procedures” as to implementation of Residential Permit Parking on all public streets in the City of Somerville Monday through Saturday, 24 hours. Effective 8-1-09.
