**Fellsway West at Jacques Street intersection**

**Jacques Street to Temple Street**

- Open to abutters ONLY
- No parking on Street from 8:00 am-4:00 pm

**Temple Street**

- Open to Abutters ONLY
- No Parking from Jacques Temple to Francis O'Brien Memorial Drive

**Francis O' Brien Memorial Drive (Somerville Housing Authority)**

- Open to Abutters ONLY
- Residents asked to exit onto Mystic Ave at Memorial Road

**Shore Drive-closed (Abutters can be brought in/out of homes by staff)**

- Open to Abutters Only
- No Parking on Street from 8:00 am-4:00 pm

City volunteers will be available on that day to assist you in leaving/returning to your property safely during the event.
