Trustees evaluate project and program proposals and approve allocations of funds used to increase the supply of affordable housing.

Meetings are held monthly typically on the second Thursday of the month. Each Trustee is expected to be able to commit at least 2 hours per month to participate in activities that include individual meeting preparation and attendance at meetings.

- 5. Have you served on a board or committee that meets on an ongoing basis? If so, please share your thoughts on what makes for a well-functioning board. What strengths do you have that would benefit the group?
