




**City of Somerville,

**ADDITIONAL VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED!**

Somerville's Docent Program operates on a scheduled basis during the months of May through October. Public openings are offered twice a month, on specific weekend days and on Thursday evenings, at three historic sites -- the Milk Row Cemetery on Somerville Avenue, Prospect Hill Tower above Union Square, and the Old Powder House in Nathan Tufts Park, off the Powder House rotary. The Docent Program was started at the Cemetery in 2012 and expanded to include the two additional historic sites in 2017. All sites are ADA accessible.

- Each opening is of two hours duration
- Period clothing is expected (and if needed, provided)
- No prior experience required; simply bring a commitment to be trained, reliable, and enthusiastic!
- Additional options to participate in City celebrations, such as First Flag on January 1, Patriots' Day in mid-April, and Veterans Memorial parade in November.
