1. Voter Information – Provide your name, the address where you are registered to vote, and date of birth. Telephone number and e-mail address are optional.
2. Ballot Information – Be sure to provide the address where you would like your ballot mailed if different from your voter registration address.
3. Assistance – If you are assisting a voter in completing this application, complete this section.
4. Sign your name – If you require assistance in signing the application, you may authorize someone to sign your name in your presence. That person must complete the assisting person's information in Section 3.

## Submitting the Application

Applications can be mailed to 93 Highland Ave, Somerville MA 02143 or hand-delivered to the drop box at the School St. entrance to City Hall. To get your ballot in a timely fashion we ask that you use the "vote in the ville" drop boxes for ballots only.

Applications may also be submitted by fax (617) 625-5643 or e-mail, as long as your signature is visible.

For November 3 State Election ballots, the application must arrive by **October 28 (Fri) da .**
