



## DO YOU WANT A FREE MONTHLY MBTA CHARLIE CARD?

The City of Somerville has launched three free public transit pass programs!



M7 Student Passes for all Somerville Public School (SPS) students from Grades 7 to 12. All students received a M7 pass in September at school. No application needed. If you have any questions about your student pass, connect with the front office staff at your school.



Monthly passes for low-income parents and guardians of SPS students. Contact your School-Based Family Liaison to learn about eligibility and availability.



500 monthly passes for low-income residents. Residents are eligible if they are enrolled in a partner program like SNAP, MassHealth, Head Start, or make up to double the federal poverty line. Contact the Community Action Agency of Somerville (CAAS) at [caasomerville.org/transit-program](https://caasomerville.org/transit-program) to learn more and apply.
