Re: Invitation for Bids 18-52: Removal and Disposal of Street Sweeping Debris

The City of Somerville (the City) is rejecting all bids received in response to IFB 18-52 – Removal and Disposal of Street Sweeping Debris.

Pursuant to M.G.L. c 30, 39M and the IFB #18-52, under Section 1.5 General Terms - Right to Cancel / Reject all bids:

The City of Somerville may cancel this solicitation, or reject in whole or in part any and all bids, if the City determines that cancellation or rejection serves the best interests of the City.

Although the City issued a Notice of Award to the lowest responsible and eligible bidder, the City and the awarded contractor jointly determined that the scope of services and specifications from the bid package require significant revisions that necessitate a re-bid of the contract.

As a result, the City has determined it is in its best interest to cancel the award notice and reject all the bids received and rebid the project with a revised and updated scope of work and specifications. The re-bid of this contract will be released on May 2nd, 2018 and bids will be due on May 17th, 2018 at 12:00PM. All interested and qualified contractors are encouraged to submit a bid. The bid package will be advertised in the Central Register and posted on the City of Somerville's Purchasing web page at <https://www.somervillema.gov/departments/finance/purchasing>.
