Re: Invitation for Bids 19-23: Fleet Vehicles for the City

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The City of Somerville (the City) is rejecting all bids received in response to IFB 19-23 – Fleet Vehicles for the City.

Pursuant to M.G.L. c 30B and the IFB #19-23, under Section 1.5 General Terms - Right to Cancel / Reject all bids:

“The City of Somerville may cancel this solicitation, or reject in whole or in part any and all bids, if the City determines that cancellation or rejection serves the best interests of the City.”

The City has determined that it is in its best interest to reject all the bids received and rebid the project with a revised clause for up-fitting. Vehicles will be bid separately according to the respective municipal departments (i.e. Department of Public Works vehicles, Water & Sewer Enterprise vehicles, and Police Department vehicles).

The new bid packages for these vehicles (IFB#19-46, IFB#19-47 and IFB #19-48) will be released in mid-December 2018 and will be due approximately two weeks after they are advertised.

The bid package will be advertised in the *Goods & Services Bulletin*, a local newspaper (*Somerville Times*) and on COMMBUYS and will be posted on the City of Somerville’s Purchasing web page at <https://www.somervillema.gov/departments/finance/purchasing>. All interested and qualified dealers are encouraged to submit a bid.
