Item #1 – Acceptance of Minutes from the September 12, 2019 Traffic Commission Meeting

Item #2 – Request for Fire Lane

Radcliffe Rd at (#23-25), from Bradley St for a distance of 20ft easterly

Item #3 – Request to temporarily create two-way traffic on Stone Avenue for a duration of approximately one month while the contractor installs box culvert sections at the intersection of Stone Ave and Somerville Ave.

Item #4 – Request to temporarily remove resident parking on Stone Avenue, for a duration of approximately one month, in three locations. If approved, this request will allow for two-way traffic on Stone Ave, and will create “passing points” for motorists in the event that two vehicles approach each other from opposite directions, given the current width of the street.

Item #5 – Request for Valet Parking Zone at 2 parking meters at 375 Revolution Dr. (K156, K157) every day from 4pm-11pm (meters will remain in effect until 4pm)

Item #6 – Request for Do Not Enter Restriction 7am-9am and 4pm-6pm except city residents and bicycles onto Morgan St from Park St
