

Results from the Powder House Boulevard Community Meeting on May 22nd and Follow-Up Online Survey

At the community meeting on May 22nd to discuss the Powder House Blvd traffic safety plan, attendees were asked to fill out a handout to help the City better understand the various comments, questions, and concerns regarding the four pavement markings options presented at the meeting. Residents were also encouraged to fill out an online survey, which asked the same questions, in the event that they were unable to attend the meeting or wanted to provide additional feedback. City staff have also received almost 100 emails regarding these options over the course of the last three months, with approximately half in support of protected bike lanes and half opposed if it were to come at the expense of on-street parking. The first chart below summarize comments from the handouts that were collected at the meeting on May 22nd, and the four charts below that summarize preferences from both the meeting handouts and online survey related to design options and parking mitigation strategies.
