Addendum No. 2 to RFQ 21-02

Addendum No. 2 is issued as a component of the Solicitation for Qualifications: RFQ #21-02. An updated version of RFQ 21-02 that reflects corrected typos and the desired submission format that are outlined in Addendum #1 and one additional change re: MCPPO clarified in Addendum #2 is posted at <u>https://www.somervillema.gov/departments/finance/purchasing</u>.

MCPPO Certification Requirement: The City will consider qualified Applicants that do not have lead staff holding a current MCPPO designation. The updated RFQ includes the following language in Section 2.7 regarding minimum requirements of Design Applicants:

"Current certification as a Massachusetts Certified Public Purchasing Official (MCPPO) demonstrated by a copy of the MCPPO certificate for relevant staff on the proposed Design Team; <u>or</u>, if the Design Team members do not hold current MCPPO designations, Applicant will commit to obtain MCPPO certification within the first year of the contract with the City of Somerville if selected as the preferred Designer."
