## Somerville Climate Forward 2022 Progress Report Highlights


Annually, the City of Somerville Office of Sustainability and Environment releases a report on the progress made on the priority actions listed in Somerville Climate Forward, the City's climate change action plan.

Somerville Climate Forward has three main goals:

- Reduce Somerville's contribution to climate change and work towards carbon neutrality (mitigation)
- Prepare Somerville for the unavoidable impacts of climate change (adaptation)
- Fairly distribute the opportunities created by climate action and work to alleviate the unequal burdens of climate change (equity)

renewed. The contract
renewal increased the
percentage of renewable
energy across all three levels
of the program. The Local
Green option doubled the
amount of renewable energy
from regional sources.



Somerville planted 637 new trees, exceeding the City's goals of 350 new trees each year. The Somerville Pollinator Action Plan Advisory Committee was formed to create the first of its kind Pollinator Action Plan. The Pollinator Action Plan will guide Somerville to support, protect, and maintain urban pollinator ecosystems.




## Somerville Climate Forward 2022 Progress Report Highlights

The City has 17 miles of unprotected bike lanes, 7 miles of protected bikes lanes, and 4 miles of offstreet path for a total of 28 miles.



Somerville's Blue Bikes bikeshare program logged 200,000 trips.



The Green Line Extension project added six new stations to the Green Line, including four stops in Somerville: Union Square, Gilman Square, Magoun Square, and Ball Square.



The Inspectional Services
Department created a new
permitting process for Fats,
Oils, and Grease
management in food
establishments. This will
keep wastewater
cleaner and prevent
blockages in wastewater
infrastructure.
