RE: Update on tenth round of HCA applications

The Marijuana Advisory Committee (MAC) reviewed one new application that was received as part of the tenth round of applications. The MAC is recommending one application for a Host Community Agreements (HCA) at this time. The MAC's thoughts on their review of the application are below.

These entities scored 16.75 points or more and are recommended for HCAs at this time:

Core Empowerment, 500 Medford St, total score: 19.25

Core Empowerment received an HCA as part of the third round; this application is for a new location by the same team. The team consists of April Arrastate (55% ownership), Tomas Gonzalez (12%), and Peri Higgins (10%), and previously received an HCA for a retail store at 288 Broadway.

Location: 4.5

- The property is in the Mid Rise 4 zoning district in the Magoun Square neighborhood. It is just over 0.25mi away from the Magoun Square GLX stop. The location is also well served by bus routes.
- The proposal is to replace a liquor store, which maintains the same type of use on the property. There are commercial vacancies in Magoun Square, so having new commercial uses in the area is good.
- Frequency of deliveries (anticipated to be multiple times per week) is a concern, but smaller sized vehicles will help address that concern.
- There is a municipal parking lot nearby that can provide parking if necessary.

Physical Space: 4.75

 The MAC likes the openness of the storefront, assuming the design will be approved by the CCC.

Operations/Industry Knowledge: 5

• The team has an impressive amount of experience across the cannabis industry, and already has a retail store operating in Boston. Also, the team provides technical assistance to other partners.

Community Involvement: 5

- The team has a solid history of engagement with the community around their Boston location, and has already begun outreach efforts to Somerville nonprofits.
- They plan to actively recruit employees from the surrounding area in acknowledgement of potential transportation challenges in the area.
