About the Event; How to buy tickets

Tour guides lead trolleys past the city's most spectacular displays of holiday pomp, sharing stories about the families that decorate and local historic trivia en route. Tours begin and end at Somerville City Hall, where refreshments are served. Entertainment at City Hall includes music by the Somerville Community Chorus and craft activities for children. Tickets go on sale on Sun., Dec. 4th at Blue Cloud Gallery, 713 Broadway in Ball Sq. Tickets are \$10 for adults; \$5 for children (12 & under) and seniors (60+). Tickets go quickly so be sure to get them early. Proceeds go toward funding the public programs of the Somerville Arts Council.

East and West Somerville Tours

Our tours focus on East and Central Somerville, but we've discovered there are also some spectacular houses in West Somerville! **To buy tickets for the West Somerville tours, request seats on the "D" trollies.** All tourgoers receive Illuminations maps, which indicate spectacular houses city-wide. So you can take a trolley tour and then also take a self-guided tour on your own time!

Where to Buy Tour Map, Book and Cards

If you can't get a ticket or want to take a self-guided tour, buy a map for \$3 at Blue Cloud Gallery and Magpie, beginning Mon., Dec. 19th; or pick up a map the night of the event, at Somerville City Hall (Dec. 17th, 5-9pm). Also that night, buy the "Somerville: City of Lights" and Nibble books for \$20 (for both!) instead of \$25. The City of Lights book (\$5) and Illuminations Holiday cards (\$2) are sold at the following stores in Somerville: Blue Cloud Gallery, 713 Broadway; Davis Squared, 409 Highland Ave.; Magpie, 416 Highland Ave., Mudflat Gallery, 36 White St, Cambridge.
