



**Carriageway Marker:**  
 in 1892, the Tufts family presented this land to the City, to be made into a public park.



**Pickle Jars:**  
 symbol of Somerville history when we specialized in farm products, such as pickles.



**Lamb:**  
 the Tufts family used this area as a farm.



**Turtle:**  
 a Native American symbol of creation.



**Quarry tools:**  
 stone from here was used for foundations, posts and gravestones.



**Millstone:**  
 Jean Maillet and family ground grain here until 1747.



**Minuteman Hat:**  
 symbol of the use of this former windmill as a powder magazine for the Continental Army.
